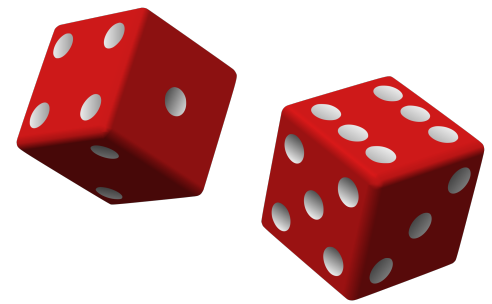
JUMANJI
