## Teacher Directions

The final project serves as a culmination of everything that the student has learned.

Print out a copy of the 10-lines template and a copy of the Rubric for each student.

Students write a story which is a minimum of ten sentences, involves a minimum of ten contractions and stays on topic throughout the entire story.

Directions to the Students:

You will be scored in five different categories.

**Content/Ideas:**

Pay attention to sticking with the same idea throughout the entire story.

**Use Contractions:**

Be sure that all of your sentences have at least one contraction.

**Use Different Contractions:**

Each of your sentences must have a different contraction that hasn't already been used.

**Handwriting:**

Your handwriting must be clear so that I can read your hard work.

**Punctuation:**

Remember how we see two different words become one that is joined by an apostrophe? That apostrophe is very important, so make sure you pay attention to all of your punctuation.
