## Graduate Certificate in Special Education Transition Services

The 100% online [Graduate Certificate in Special Education Transition Services](#) is comprised of three special education courses and one counseling course with a concentrated focus on career development and counseling to facilitate transition from secondary education to adult settings. The courses are:

- SPED 5306 Transition Services for Individuals with Disabilities
- SPED 5307 Transition Assessment and Instruction
- SPED 5309 Leadership in Transition Services
- COUN 5370 Career Counseling Across the Lifespan

Individuals can take the coursework for the certificate as a stand-alone program, or they may include the certificate in the Master of Education in Special Education for a master's degree with a focus on transition services.

To apply, submit a graduate application, application fee (\$45 domestic, \$75 international), official transcript from baccalaureate degree granting institution, a letter of interest, and two references.

Admissions deadlines are as follows:

- Spring enrollment = Apply by Nov. 15th
- Summer enrollment = Apply by April 15th
- Fall enrollment = Apply by July 15<sup>th</sup>
