### Chapter 21 Questions

Directions: Use complete sentences to answer the following questions.

1. Why can't Charlotte go back to the barn?

Charlotte tells Wilbur that she's "done for" and that "in a day or two [she'll]  
be dead" (page 165). She has no more strength left in her nor any web  
left to help her move around.

2. Why is Wilbur so upset after he talks with Charlotte?

Wilbur is upset after talking with Charlotte because she is not going  
back home with Wilbur and that his friend is dying. (Page 165).

3. What deal did Wilbur make with Templeton?

Wilbur made a deal with Templeton by telling him that he "will let [Templeton]  
eat first, when Lurvy slops [him]... and [he] won't touch a thing until  
[Templeton is ] through" in exchange for Templeton to get Charlotte's egg sac.  
(Page 168).

4. How do you feel at the end of this chapter? Why?
